Troop Roles	Description	Background Check Required
Camp Certified Adult	Do you think all girls should experience the fun of the outdoors? As the outdoor trained adult you will help bring the Girl Scout camping tradition to life. You will prepare the girls and troop adults, accompany your troop on camping trips and ensure proper Girl Scout camping/cooking procedures are followed.	Yes
First Aid/CPR Adult	Are you safety conscience - always thinking ahead and making sure you are prepared for anything? This position requires you to be certified in First Aid and CPR. At least one trained volunteer is required for troop trips and outings where medical services are not readily available. Training is available!	Yes
Troop Co-Leader	Are you looking for the perfect opportunity to become a role model for girls? Do you want to help girls discover the possibilities within them? Then this is the role for you! Work together with another volunteer to help plan troop meetings, bring the Girl Scout program to life, and help girls broaden their experience of the world around them.	Yes
Troop Cookie Manager	Do you love Girl Scout Cookies? Help manage your troop's cookie sale. As Troop Cookie Manager you will help distribute cookies and information, and track troop sales. This is a great opportunity for anyone who is very organized.	Yes
Troop Fall Sale Manager	Help troops earn start-up money for the new troop year with a quick and easy sale. Manage the fall product sale, distribute sale information, and promote the sale to membership to ensure success.	Yes
Troop Treasurer	Do you enjoy putting the financial pieces of the puzzle together? Assist the troop in the management of the troop finances and be a steward of the girls' bank account. Discuss with all leaders how troop money will be handled.	Yes
Troop Trip Chaperone and Driver	Would you like to experience all the adventures of Girl Scouting with your daughter? This position will allow you to transport girls to events and on occasion will require overnight stays.	Yes

Alternate Delegate	Do you want to represent the girl and adult members from your geographic area in the Council's governance system? In this role you will be you area's voice at the council level at the annual meeting (usually held in March) throughout the year on council policies and procedures. This is a two year appointment and requires a vote from the local membership.	Yes
Area Cookie Booth Coordinator	Would you like to help troops boost their cookie sales? Assist troops in meeting their cookie sale goals by developing and fostering relationships with local businesses willing to allow Girl Scout cookie booths at their locations.	Yes
Area Cookie Cupboard Coordinator	Do you have a little extra space? You can help make cookies more accessible to the troops in your community by serving as the Area Cookie Cupboard Coordinator and housing/distributing cookies during the annual Girl Scout cookie sale.	Yes
Area Cookie Manager	Do you love the Girl Scout cookie sale? As area Cookie Manager, you can help troops succeed by promoting the sale, providing support to troops and managing the details of the sale for your area.	Yes
Area Cookie Rally Coordinator	Do you get excited about the start of the cookie sale? As the Cookie Rally Coordinator, you can share your excitement by planning an event to promote the annual Cookie Sale. You can help girls boost their sales, learn selling safety tips and educate them on the benefits of participating the sale.	Yes
Area Fall Rally Coordinator	Do you get excited about the beginning of a new Girl Scout year? As the Area Fall Rally Coordinator, you can share your excitement by planning an event to promote the Fall Product Sale and help troops earn start-up funds for the year.	Yes
Area Fall Sale Manager	Would you like to help troops earn start-up funds for the new year? The Fall Sale helps the girls do just that in a quick and easy sale. The Fall Sale Manager helps to distribute information, promote and manage the sale to ensure troop success.	Yes
Area Family Partnership Coordinator	Is supporting the Girl Scout movement important to you? Help others understand the importance of their financial support by sharing your Girl Scout experience and passion for the movement.	Yes
Area Recognitions Coordinator	Do you believe in recognizing the good deeds of others? In this role you will help recognize leadership and service to our organization both on a local and Council level. You will have the opportunity to work with volunteers in your area to plan annual and ongoing recognitions.	Yes

Area Service Unit Manager	Are you passionate about the Girl Scout program? As a Service Unit Manager, you can share you knowledge and passion for the program by providing guidance and support to leaders in your area at monthly Service Unit meetings and beyond.	Yes
Area Treasurer	Do you enjoy putting the financial pieces of the puzzle together? As the Area Treasurer, you will be responsible for collecting and depositing funds and monitoring revenue and expenditures for the Service Unit/Area.	Yes
Area Troop Organizer	How well do you know your community? Use the connections you already have and create new partnerships while helping to secure new meeting locations for Girl Scout troops as your local troop organizer.	Yes
Bi-Lingual GSLE Coach	Are you a bilingual Girl Scout parent or alum? Do you want to share the Girl Scout experience in a mentoring and support role? The Bilingual GSLE Coach is for you! Work alongside new Spanish-speaking-preferred leaders in a 9-week plan to help develop the leadership skills necessary to run a new troop.	Yes
Community Champion-Hispanic	Are you outgoing, do you enjoy talking with people and spreading the word about girl leadership activities? GS-NCCP seeks bilingual volunteers for our Community Champion role! Attend festivals, speak at member events and be a face-to-face advocate for Girl Scouts in our Hispanic Initiative. Time commitment includes 4-6 weekends per year at 2-4 hours each day.	Yes
Community Service Coordinator	Do you believe in the importance of helping girls give back to their community? Help plan, communicate with troops and execute community service projects in your geographic area.	Yes

Program Coach	Are you a Girl Scout program guru? Help other volunteers understand the basics of the program and link them to local and council resources by being a Girl Scout program coach in your community.	Yes
